

## SUMMARY

The Bautex Block is a high-performance lightweight insulated concrete block made from expanded polystyrene (EPS) and a proprietary cementitious mix for use in commercial concrete wall construction. Construction using Bautex blocks is simple and straightforward. Workers utilize existing construction techniques, skills, and tools. With training provided by Bautex, contractors can quickly and confidently build with Bautex Block.

This list of trades provides general contractors and project designers a helpful summarization of interactions with the Bautex wall system. Since every project is different not all of these trades may be on every job. ### Trades With Scope Interactions:

- **Mason:** Bautex Block install and masonry veneer
- **Structural Steel:** tie backs, integral columns, floor/roof joists, structural beams, etc.
- **Interiors:** drywall, furring channels, blocking, etc.
- **Plaster Installer:** exterior stucco finish and interior plaster finish
- **Waterproofer:** air and moisture barrier, flashing, etc.
- **Roofer:** TPO/roofing on parapets, canopies, awnings, etc.
- **Glazing:** window and storefront systems
- **MEP:** mechanical, electrical, and plumbing in the walls, thru-wall penetrations, mechanical/electrical fixtures and wall-hung equipment, etc.
- **Panel Systems:** rain screens, Nichiha, metal wall panels, etc.
- **Millwork:** cabinetry, signage, etc.
